### **CABLELOGIC LAUNCHES RENEWABLE ENERGY TO THE PILBARA!**

Local data & communication cabling firm, Cablelogic, announces the launch of its renewable energy division, Renewablelogic, to the Pilbara region.

Already well established in the Perth area, Renewablelogic will expand on the services offered by Cablelogic to include a number of sustainable energy solutions, with a strong focus on providing solar power systems for residential and commercial use.

“Recognising a need for renewable energy services in the Pilbara has been a key driver behind this move. We believe demand will increase as electricity prices continue to rise and people start to look at ways to better manage their energy consumption,” company Director Brett Easton said.

There are a number of additional advantages to owning a solar power system in the Pilbara. From the longer periods of exposure to the sun, to the added benefit of selling excess power produced during working hours back to the grid. However none are more relevant than the reduction in the cost of electricity, particularly as the price of power has risen in the past two months by an average of 20%.

Another benefit of solar power is the rebate offered on the purchase of a solar system. Currently, the previous solar rebate has been cancelled and the new ‘Solar Credits Rebate’ is waiting to be passed by parliament but should be confirmed in August 2009. However, any solar power systems that are purchased from June 9, 2009 will be eligible for this rebate once legislated.

Although the solar rebate is undecided the Government still provides an incentive to business owners who are considering solar. The Australian Tax Office has recently confirmed that the Government's Capital Investment tax incentive of 50% also applies to solar power systems. This means that businesses which turn over less than \$2 million annually are able to claim an additional 50% against the cost to purchase a solar power system until 31<sup>st</sup> December 2009.

"For many people its not all about saving money, it is about better managing the resources that they have, and increasing the value of their private or commercial premises. Whilst for some the decision is based solely upon reducing their greenhouse gas emissions," said Brett Easton.
